You are directed to notify the inhabitants of the Town of Acton who are qualified to vote in elections and town affairs, to assemble at:

Then and there to Act on the following Articles:

Article 1. To see if the District will vote to appropriate the sum of \$1,095,000.00 to acquire by purchase, gift, eminent domain, or otherwise, a parcel of land at 585 Main Street, Acton, Massachusetts owned or formerly owned by Brewster Conant, containing 11.23 acres, more or less, being the land described in a deed recorded in the Middlesex County Registry of Deeds in Book 10678, Page 299; and that to meet this appropriation the Treasurer with the approval of the Board of Water Commissioners be authorized to apply for funds from any private or public grant or aid programs, accept gifts, or to borrow \$1,095,000.00 and to issue bonds or notes of the District therefor, under M.G.L. c. 44, §7(1); said land being acquired for the purposes of protecting the groundwater aquifers and recharge areas for water supply wells, conserving the land for watershed protection purposes, and for all things pertinent to its rights and duties as a Massachusetts water district per its enabling act, Chapter 326 of the Acts of 1912, as amended, and under the provisions of M.G.L. c. 40 and c. 79; or to take any other action relative thereto.

Article 2. To see if the District will vote to accept a transfer of real property from the Town of Acton of the property located at 3-33 Knox Trail in Acton, shown as Lot 12 on Land Court Plan No. 25398E, and shown as Parcel ID J3-21-2, containing 1.5 acres, more or less, for the purposes of protecting the groundwater aquifers and recharge areas for water supply wells, and conserving the land for watershed protection purposes, and for all things pertinent to its rights and duties as a Massachusetts water district per its enabling act, Chapter 326 of the Acts of 1912, as amended, and under the provisions of M.G.L. c. 40 and c. 79, or to take any other action relative thereto.

Hereof fail not and make due returns of this Warrant with your doings thereon to the Water Commissioners on or before the time of holding of said meeting.
